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1. Introduction:

To assess the quality of our educational programs, services, and facilities, as well as to identify areas for improvement and enhancement; each year Darrang College conducts a Feedback survey among the teaching staff of college to provide actionable insights that will inform decision-making and initiatives aimed at enhancing the overall development of the institution.

This report has been prepared based on the feedback received from the teaching staff of Darrang College during March 2024. This report provides a comprehensive overview of the feedback gathered from the teaching staff. It serves as a valuable tool for assessing the quality of our educational programs, services, and facilities, as well as identifying key areas for improvement and enhancement.

Aims and Objective of the survey: This report serves as a valuable tool for:

- Providing actionable insights that will inform decision-making and initiatives aimed at enhancing the overall experience.

2. Methodology:

2.1 Population of study: All the Teachers of Darrang College.

2.2 Sample Size of the sample is 84.

2.3 Sampling Technique: Total 86 no's of Teachers responded to the survey out of which 84 responses are selected for final data interpretation. 2 responses are rejected for various reasons like incomplete demographic data, blank responses etc.

2.4 Tools used for data collection: A 15-item nonstandardized self-prepared 5-point Likert scale is used to understanding various aspects of the students' college experience, including teaching and learning, campus resources, extracurricular activities, and student support services. The Likert scale was created by Rensis Likert in 1932. The Likert scale is a type of rating scale. A rating scale is a measurement instrument used to determine a respondent's attitude toward self, others, or situations. Since it is 5 points, it contains a midpoint and allows respondents to be undecided. The purpose of the Likert scale is to determine a respondent's attitude or opinion regarding themselves, others, or situations. The Likert scale allows researchers to obtain quantitative data from qualitative notions such as providing respondents with a statement and asking them to respond on an agree/disagree continuum (Waltz, T.B.2023)

Google form: A link is created by using Google form including the survey questioner. Google Forms is a survey administration software included as part of the free, web-based Google Docs Editors suite offered by Google. The service also includes Google Docs, Google Sheets, Google Slides, Google Drawings, Google Sites, and Google Keep. Google Forms is only available as a web application. The app allows users to create and edit

surveys online while collaborating with other users in real-time. The collected information can be automatically entered into a spreadsheet (Wikipedia 2024).

Procedure: The Google form including survey questioner circulated to the Teachers of Darrang College during 03/04/2024 to 11/04/2024 through the website of Darrang College Tezpur . Total 86 no's of Teachers responded to the survey out of which 84 responses are selected for final data interpretation.

Statistical tools: For analysis of data Table, Pie chart, Line graph etc are used.

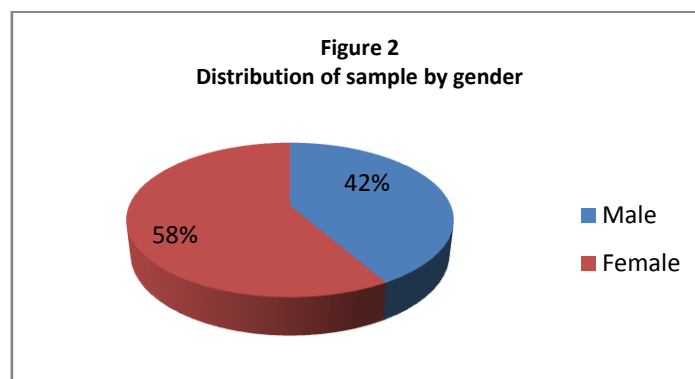


Figure 1 shows the diagrammatic representation of Table 1, it is observed that among 84 respondents 42 % Male and 58% Female.

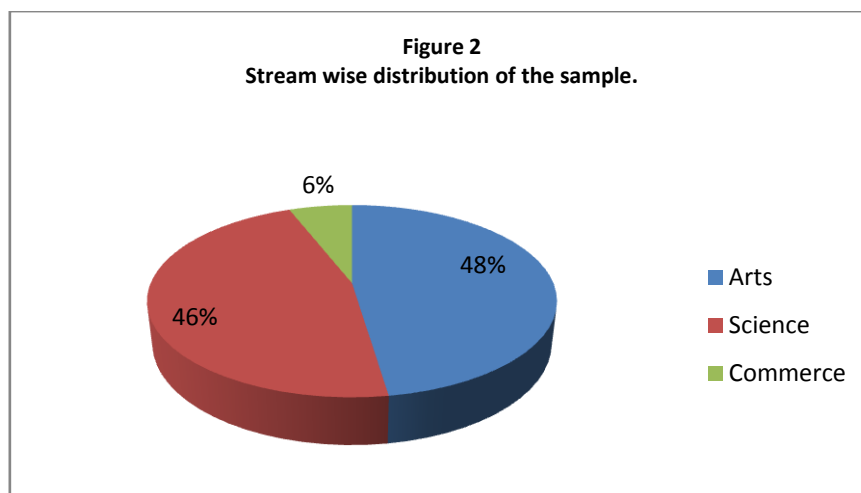

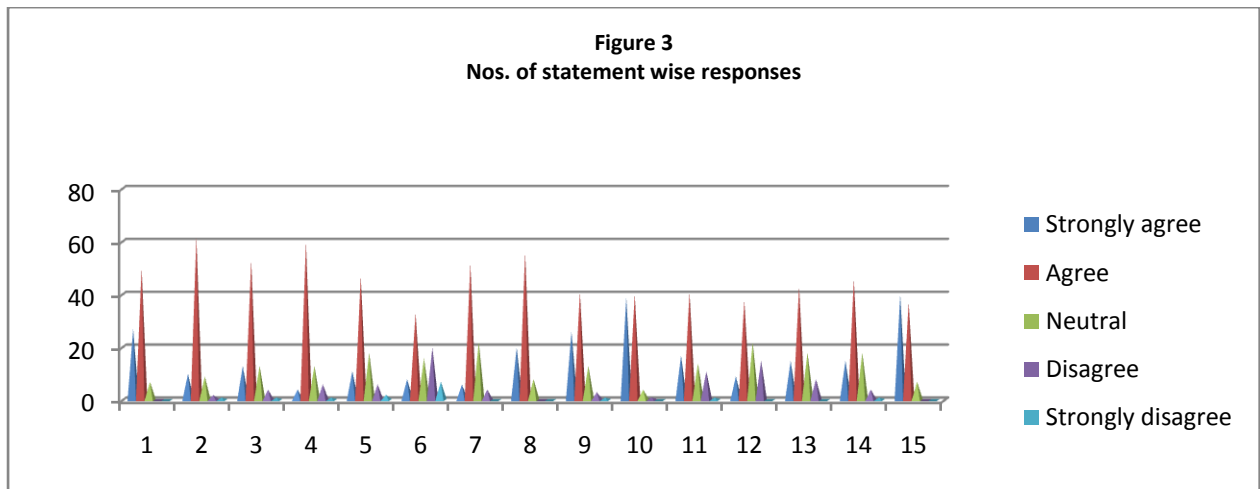


Figure 3 shows the diagrammatic representation of Table 3.

In statement 2 (i.e. The The curriculum has good academic flexibility.)10 respondent responded as strongly agree, 62 respondent responded as Agree ,9 respondent responded as Neutral, 2 respondent responded as disagree and 1 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 3(i.e. The course contentfulfils the need of the students.)13 respondent responded as strongly agree, 53 respondent responded as Agree,13respondent responded as Neutral, 4 respondent responded as disagree and 1 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 4 (i.e. Syllabus is suitable for both slow and fast learners.)4respondent responded as strongly agree, 60 respondent responded as Agree,13 respondent responded as Neutral, 6 respondent responded as disagree and 1 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 5(i.e. Syllabus has job readiness capability.)11 respondent responded as strongly agree, 47 respondent responded as Agree,18 respondent responded as Neutral, 6 respondent responded as disagree and 2 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 6 (i.e. Time framework is suitable for completion of the syllabus during the semester.)8 respondent responded as strongly agree, 33 respondent responded as Agree,16 respondent responded as Neutral, 20 respondent responded as disagree and 7 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 7 (i.e.The course of the study carries sufficient number of optional papers for students.) 6 respondent responded as strongly agree, 52 respondent responded as Agree,22 respondent responded as Neutral, 4 respondent responded as disagree and 0 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 8 (i.e. The course of the subject has made you more interested in the subject area.) 20 respondent responded as strongly agree, 56 respondent responded as Agree, 8

respondent responded as Neutral, 0 respondent responded as disagree and 0 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 9 (i.e. I have the freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of testing and making assessment of students.) 26 respondent responded as strongly agree, 41 respondent responded as Agree, 13 respondent responded as Neutral, 3 respondent responded as disagree and 1 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 10 (i.e. Evaluation system adopted by the institution is transparent.) 39 respondent responded as strongly agree, 40 respondent responded as Agree, 4 respondent responded as Neutral, 1 respondent responded as disagree and 0 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 11 (i.e. The prescribed books for students are available in the library.) 17 respondent responded as strongly agree, 41 respondent responded as Agree, 14 respondent responded as Neutral, 11 respondent responded as disagree and 1 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

In statement 12 (i.e. Computer based facilities are made available for ICT enabled teaching to students in classroom.) 9 respondent responded as strongly agree, 38 respondent responded as Agree, 22 respondent responded as Neutral, 15 respondent responded as disagree and 0 respondent responded as strongly disagree.

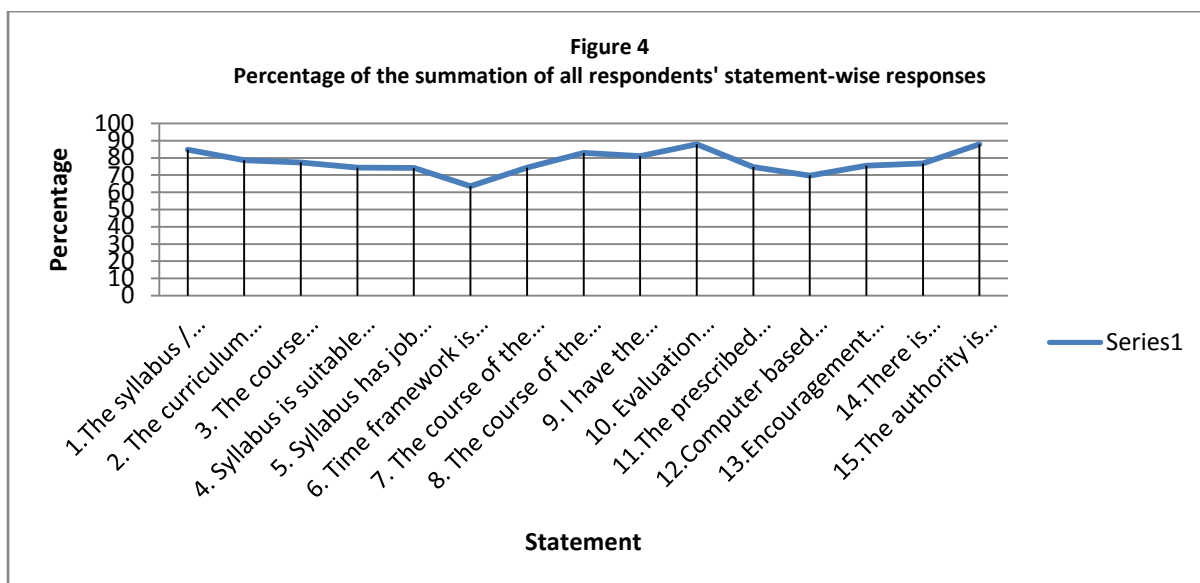


Figure 4 shows the diagrammatic representation of Table 4, By analyzing table 4 and Figure 4, A high percentage is observed in statement 10 (88%) and statement 15(88%) followed by statement 1 (85%) and statement 8(83%) . A low Percentage is observed in statement 6 (64%) followed by 12(70%).

4. Conclusion:

The conclusion can be drawn from the analysis of the feedback of the teachers that teachers are satisfied with the course that they teach and evaluation system of the college. The teachers find the authority approachable and the office staff cooperative. Not having sufficient ICT tools for teaching sometimes make them lag behind. Still they are trying their best to give the best of the learning experience to the students despite having the time constraint to finish the syllabus in astipulated time.
