

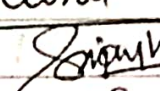

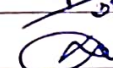

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Highlights of the Meeting

- ① Prof. Bhabsen Tanti Sir suggested to specifically mention program outcomes and course outcomes in each semester.
 - Sir suggested to mention program outcomes nicely so that students get to know more about the scope of Botany. Program outcomes must be in points mentioning about the importance of Botany.
 - Regarding course outcomes, it should also be well defined. Course outcomes must be in points on the basis of the units covered in the syllabus, i.e. one point for each unit.
- ② Dr. Anupam Sir suggested to change the number of classes and number of hours to be taught. It is not in the proper order. It should be modified.

- ③ Dr. Rheetopanna Malam suggested some modifications in the syllabus of 1st sem SEC.
 - Some of the topics can be omitted, estimation of antioxidants must be excluded.
- ④ Mununori Rao Malam suggested to keep environmental ethics in the SEC only, while BT sir suggested to keep environmental ethics in the VAC course.
- ⑤ Dr. Anupam sir suggested to provide environmental law under VAC programme. SEC must be practical oriented.
- ⑥ Dr. Anupam sir suggested to conduct the production of spawn through students under SEC.
