3. Agenda of the Meeting

- To place the proposed syllabi of the Department of Bengali before the Board of Studies.
- To discuss, review, and suggest necessary modifications in the course structure and contents.
- To finalize the syllabi for submission to the Academic Council for approval.

4. Discussion on Syllabi

The proposed syllabi of the FYUGP courses, including Major, Minor, AEC, SEC courses of the Department of Bengali, were placed before the Board. Detailed discussions were held on course objectives, learning outcomes, relevance to contemporary studies, and alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) framework.

The external experts and members actively participated in the deliberations and provided valuable academic suggestions to enrich the curriculum and make it more comprehensive, inclusive, and student-oriented.

5. Resolutions and Recommendations of the Board

After thorough discussion, the following suggestions were unanimously recommended by the Board of Studies:

Inclusion of Travelogue or Detective Literature:

It was suggested that either *Travel Literature* or *Detective Literature* may be considered for inclusion in the syllabus to broaden literary exposure and enhance students' interest.

Folk Literature Presentation Paper:

A presentation-based paper on *Folk Literature* was recommended to be included in the **8th Semester of the Honours with Research programme**, considering its academic and cultural significance.

Women Writers in Short Stories:

The Board suggested the addition of selected short stories written by **women writers** to ensure gender representation and inclusivity in the syllabus.

Replacement of Author:

The author **Nihar Ranjan Ray** (author of *Bangāli Itihas*) was recommended to be replaced by **Subhas Mukhopadhyay**, considering academic suitability and relevance.

Addition of Brahma Samaj History:

The **History of the Brahma Samaj** was recommended to be included to provide students with a broader understanding of socio-religious reform movements in Bengal.

Inclusion of 'Maimansingha Gitika':

The Board suggested the inclusion of the text '**Maimansingha Gitika**' as an important component of folk and ballad literature.

6. Resolution

After incorporating the above suggestions, the Board of Studies **unanimously resolved** to approve the revised syllabi of the Department of Bengali and recommended the same for submission to the **Academic Council of Darrang College (Autonomous)** for final approval.

7. Vote of Thanks and Conclusion

There being no other matter to discuss, the meeting concluded with a formal vote of thanks to the Chair. The Chairperson expressed sincere gratitude to all members, especially the external experts, for their constructive suggestions and valuable guidance in strengthening the academic framework of the department.
