3. Agenda of the Meeting

- To place the proposed syllabi of the Department of Bengali before the Board of Studies.
- To discuss, review, and suggest necessary modifications in the course structure and contents.
- To finalize the syllabi for submission to the Academic Council for approval.

4. Discussion on Syllabi

The proposed syllabi of the FYUGP courses, including Major, Minor, AEC, SEC courses of the Department of Bengali, were placed before the Board. Detailed discussions were held on course objectives, learning outcomes, relevance to contemporary studies, and alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) framework.

The external experts and members actively participated in the deliberations and provided valuable academic suggestions to enrich the curriculum and make it more comprehensive, inclusive, and student-oriented.

5. Resolutions and Recommendations of the Board

After detailed deliberation and discussion, the following recommendations were unanimously approved by the Board of Studies:

A. Inclusion of *Chandimangal Kabya*

The Board recommended the inclusion of *Chandimangal Kabya* in the syllabus in place of *Shibayan Kabya*, *Dharmmangal Kabya*, and the works of poet *Ketokadas Kshemananda*.

B. Modification of Paper Titles

The paper titles “**Unish Shataker Bangla Sahityer Itihas**” and “**Bish Shataker Bangla Sahityer Itihas**” have been revised as follows:

- a. *Adhunik Bangla Sahityer Itihas – Porbo I*
- b. *Adhunik Bangla Sahityer Itihas – Porbo II*

C. Restructuring of Paper Content

The contents of papers **BEN-MJ-04014** and **BEN-MJ-04024** have been reorganized. Topics related to **Rabindranath Tagore** have been included in paper **BEN-MJ-04024** and removed from **BEN-MJ-04014**.

D. Revision in Folk Literature Component

Under the Folk Literature section of the **4th Semester Major**, *Chandrabati Pala* has been added, while *Shiyal Pandit* and *Tushla Brata* have been removed.

E. Revision in SEC Course Content

In the **3rd Semester SEC paper**, **Translation of English Paragraphs** has been introduced in place of the prescribed text *Robinson Crusoe*.

6. Resolution

After incorporating the above suggestions, the Board of Studies resolved to approve the revised syllabi of the Department of Bengali and recommended the same for submission to the **Academic Council of Darrang College (Autonomous)** for final approval.

7. Vote of Thanks and Conclusion

There being no other matter to discuss, the meeting concluded with a formal vote of thanks. The Chairperson expressed sincere gratitude to all members, especially the external experts, for their constructive suggestions and valuable guidance in strengthening the academic framework of the department.
