Proceedings and Resolutions:

Welcome Address

The meeting commenced with a welcome address by the Head of the Department, who briefed the members about the agenda of the meeting.

The following agenda items were then taken up for discussion:

Agenda Item No. 1: Approval of the ITEP Syllabus

Dr. Anamika Das, Faculty and Member, BoS, placed before the Board the syllabus of the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP), prepared by adopting the NCTE-prescribed curriculum with minor modifications to suit the institutional requirements. The members discussed the proposed syllabus in detail and offered a few suggestions, which were incorporated wherever considered appropriate.

Resolution No. 1

Resolved that the ITEP syllabus of the Department of Education, as discussed and modified during the meeting, be approved by the Board of Studies and recommended to the Academic Council for its consideration and approval.

Agenda Item No. 2: Minor Modification of the Course: Development of Education in India (3rd Semester Major, EDU-MJ-03024 and 4th Semester Minor, EDU-MN-04024)

Dr. Anamika Das, placed the proposed minor modifications to the course before the Board. The changes, which had been circulated earlier, were discussed by the members.

Resolution No. 2

Resolved that the proposed minor modifications to the course *Development of Education in India* (3rd Semester Major and 4th Semester Minor) be approved by the Board of Studies and recommended to the Academic Council for approval.

Agenda Item No. 3: Renaming and Revision of the Course: Educational Statistics and Practical ((EDU-MJ-06024)

Dr. Anamika Das, placed before the Board the proposal to rename the course **Educational Statistics and Practical** as **Educational Statistics** by removing the Practical examination component. During the discussion, the members appreciated the proposal and suggested that while the Practical examination component may be discontinued, practical learning should continue through suitable assignments, activities, or other forms of continuous assessment within the course. The members agreed that such practical components would enhance students' understanding of educational statistics without requiring a separate practical examination.

Resolution No. 3

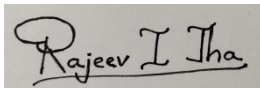
Resolved that the course **Educational Statistics and Practical** be renamed as **Educational Statistics**. The Board further resolved that the Practical examination component be discontinued; however, practical aspects of the course shall be incorporated through appropriate assignments, activities, or other continuous assessment tasks. The revised course, with the above modification, is approved by the Board of Studies and recommended to the Academic Council for its consideration and approval.

Vote of Thanks

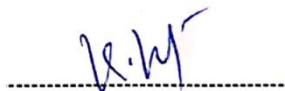
The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by **Prof. Ringprangdi Thaosen**, Department of Education, Darrang College.
