Darrang College Women's Forum was formed in the year 2017 with the following mission and vision.

Mission: To engage in programs and activities that contributes to the personal and professional development of our members, our students and the community and helps them to achieve success on their own.

Vision: To lead and inspire every Darrangian to make positive contribution to the society.

We have 52 members from teaching and non teaching staff recently. It varies as entries of new members and exit due to retirement.

We have our own constitution to run the forum smoothly as follows:

Preamble:

“ We, the female teaching and non-teaching members of the staff of Darrang College having solemnly resolved to constitute a women's forum to secure Honor, Dignity and Solidarity of the women staff of the college and work with a united effort to achieve the objectives, pledge to give effect to various provisions of the constitution of the forum.”

In our Constituent assembly, the 20 days 11 months 2017 year, we do hereby adopt, enact and give to ourselves this constitution.

Aims and objectives:

- To work for the cause of women.
- The Forum will work for the all round development of its members, extend its activities for community service and students' welfare.

To attain the aforementioned objectives the following initiatives will be taken by the forum:

Academic:

In academic arena basically discussions, workshops, seminars, campaigning, distribution of pamphlets etc. will be included.

Non-academic:

The non-academic area includes basically field trips, community based programmes, film screening, celebrating special occasions etc.

Structure of the Organization:

Two executive members

Method of Work:

All works of the forum will be performed through general discussion in the meetings. To take the final decision the simple majority procedure will be followed. However, in case of emergency, the decision of the Executive Body will be regarded as final.

Quorum: To hold a meeting at least one tenth of the total members must be present. If the quorum is not fulfilled the President can post-pond the meeting.

Rules and regulations for the members:

Acquiring membership: All women, teaching and non-teaching office staff will be the member of the forum.

Termination of membership: Any members who violets the rules and regulations of the forum will be terminated from the membership immediately.

The constitution is open for amendment if need arises. The amendment will be effective with the approval of majority of the members.

Fund Generation:

Annual fee: Annual fees of rupees five hundred will be paid by each member by the month of February of each financial year.

Special fee: Special fees will be collected from the members as and when need arises.

The accounts of the Forum will be audited once in a year by the Auditors to be nominated by General Body.

The Account shall be jointly operated by any two members. The signatory will comprise of the treasurer, the Secretary and President-out of which two can withdraw the amount, however a condition prevails that the treasure's signature is mandatory at the time of withdrawal.

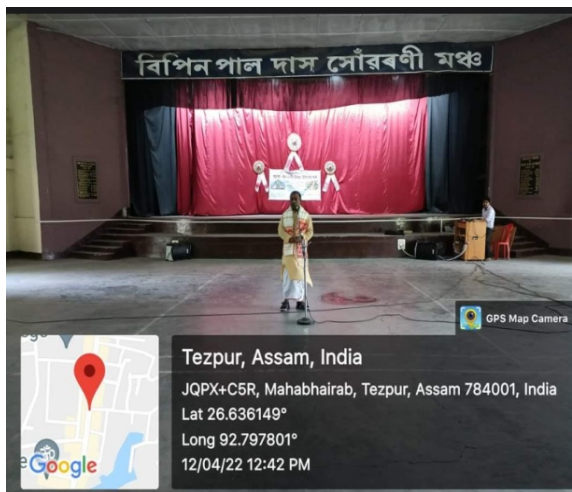
Wall magazine "Surujmukhi" was inaugurated.

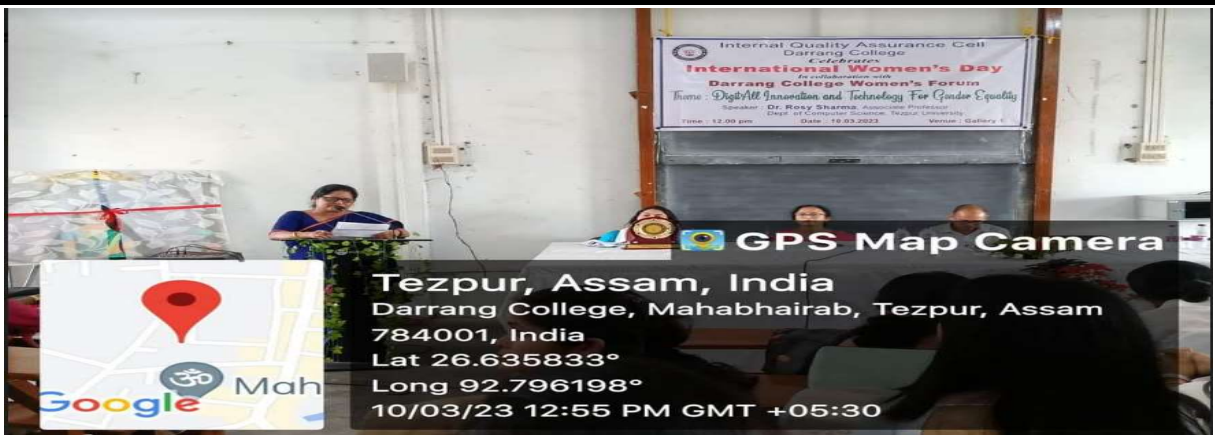

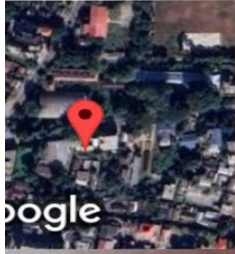
