Coordination:


Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/ research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee, consisting of (a) in president of Madhab Mandir Bahumukhi Prakalpa , Tezpur, or his/ her nominee, (b) Principal, Darrang College, Tezpur, or his/ her nominee, (c) Programme Coordinator from the side of Madhab Mandir Bahumukhi Prakalpa, and (d) Programme Coordinator from the side of Darrang College, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

Tenure and Termination:


This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for 5 years and may be continued thereafter, after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither Madhab Mandir Bahumukhi Prakalpa, Tezpur nor Darrang College will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institution may suffer. However, Madhab Mandir Bahumukhi Prakalpa, Tezpur and Darrang College, Tezpur will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

Arbitration clause:






