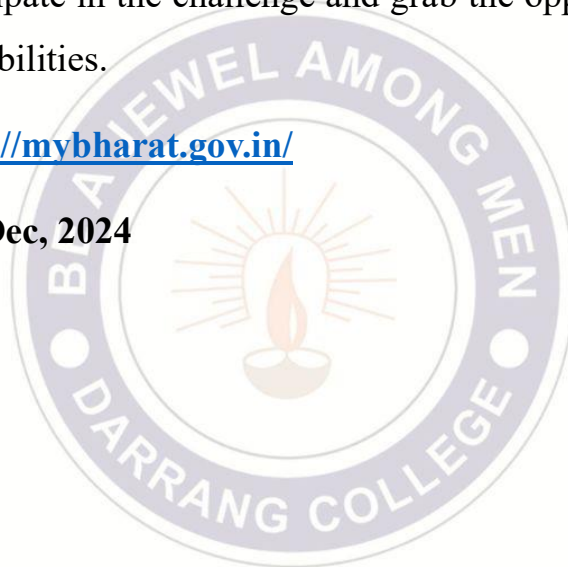

Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to bring to your kind notice that a transformative reimagining of the **National Youth Festival (NYF)**, 2025 has been announced. Echoing the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision for heightened youth participation in shaping India's future, the reimagined festival will be called the "**Vikshit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue**".

The event aims to inspire youth participation in nation-building, aligning with the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision of shaping a progressive and inclusive India. In total, about 3000 youths will be selected through verticals for the national event at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi on 11-12 January, 2025. The first group comprises of the participants selected from the "Vikshit Bharat Challenge". The "Vikshit Bharat Challenge" is being organized in four stages/rounds to select around 1,500 youths who will attend the national event at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi, on 11th-12th January 2025. The details of the stages are as follows:

**Stage 1: Vikshit Bharat Quiz (25th November – 5th December 2024)**

- **Theme:** The theme of the Quiz would be "Landmark achievements of Bharat"
- **Format:** Digital quiz hosted on the Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat) platform.
- **Registration:** Open to individuals aged 15–29 years on the MY Bharat portal at <https://mybharat.gov.in>.

**Stage 2: Essay/Blog Writing (8th December – 15th December 2024)**

- Participants who qualify Stage 1 will demonstrate their creativity and analytical thinking by writing essays or blogs on themes related to India's progress and vision.

**Stage 3: Vikshit Bharat Vision Pitch Deck – State-Level Presentations (20th December – 22nd December 2024)**

- Selected participants will present innovative ideas and solutions for India's development at the state level in a pitch deck format.

**Stage 4: Vikshit Bharat National Championship (11th – 12th January 2025)**

- Finalists will compete at the national event in Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi, showcasing their leadership, vision, and potential to contribute to a *Vikshit Bharat*.

In this regard, I would like to request you kindly to take initiative to encourage students of Gauhati University to register and participate actively in the "Vikshit Bharat Quiz". Additionally, you may engage affiliated colleges, departments, and youth units such as NCC, NSS, and NYK in this effort.
