3. MODE OF ADMISSION:

Admission to the ITEP (B.A.-B.Ed. and B.Sc.-B.Ed.) programme will be based strictly on **merit**, as determined by the **NTA-NCET 2026 score**. Eligible candidates must apply through the Assam **SAMARTH** Admission portal as notified by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Assam.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

To be Eligible for Admission, the candidate must:

- i) Have passed the **H.S. (10+2)** or equivalent examination from a recognized board.
- ii) Have qualified in the **NTA-NCET 2026** Examination.
- iii) Have secured a minimum of:

- a) **50 %** for General category
- b) **47 %** for OBC/MOBC (Non-Creamy Layer)
- c) **45 %** for SC/ST

5. RESERVATION POLICY:

Reservation of seats for various categories of candidates shall be made in accordance with the prevailing Reservation policy of the Government of Assam applicable to State government-funded Higher Educational Institutions.

Note: Candidates applying under **Reserved category** must present the **original and valid supporting documents** at the time of Admission. Acceptable documents include the **Caste Certificate, NCL, EWS certificate, Extracurricular certificates, etc.** all of which must be issued by competent authority.

In the event that no eligible candidates are available under a particular reserved category, the vacant seats will be converted to the **Open Category** and filled on **based on merit** during **spot Admission**.

6. RESTRICTIONS:

- a) **For B.A.-B.Ed.:** All students must choose any one of the following subjects (**different from Core 1**) as Minor Course: **Assamese, Bengali, Bodo, Economics, Education, English, Geography, Hindi, History, Political Science, Sanskrit, Sociology.**

- b) **For B.Sc.-B.Ed.:** All students must choose any one of the following subjects (different from Core 1) as Minor Course: **Botany, Computer Science, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics and Zoology**

7. **ADMISSION PROCESS:**

The entire process of admission will be conducted online through the SAMARTH Portal: <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>. Candidates must register and submit their applications within the specified timeline as notified by the Director of Higher Education, Assam. Offline or manual applications will not be accepted under any circumstances.

8. **FINAL NOTES**

- a) Admission shall remain provisional until all original documents have been verified by the college authorities.
- b) Any admission secured on the basis of false, inaccurate, or misleading information shall be cancelled immediately.
- c) The college reserves the right to amend, revise, or modify its admission policy in accordance with any guidelines, notifications, or directives issued by the Government of Assam or other competent regulatory authorities.
