3. **MODE OF APPLICATION:** Eligible candidates must apply through the Assam **SAMARTH** Admission portal (<https://assamadmitep.samarth.ac.in/index.php>) as notified by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Assam.

### 4. **MODE OF ADMISSION:**

Admission to the **ITEP (B.A.-B.Ed. and B.Sc.-B.Ed.)** programme will be based strictly on **merit**, as determined by the **NTA-NCET 2026 score**. Merit list would be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in NTA-NCET Score **based on marks obtained in 4 Compulsory Subjects and the domain specific optional paper**.

### 5. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

To be Eligible for Admission, the candidate must:

- i) Have passed the **H.S. (10+2)** or equivalent examination from a recognized board.
- ii) Have qualified in the **NTA-NCET 2026** Examination.

### 6. **RESERVATION POLICY:**

Reservation of seats for various categories of candidates shall be made in accordance with the prevailing Reservation policy of the Government of Assam applicable to State government-funded Higher Educational Institutions.

**Note:** Candidates applying under **Reserved category** must present the **original and valid supporting documents** at the time of Admission. Acceptable documents include the **Caste Certificate, NCL, EWS certificate, Extracurricular certificates, etc.** all of which must be issued by competent authority.

**For reservation under OBC category, NCL certificate is compulsory.**

In the event that no eligible candidates are available under a particular reserved category, the vacant seats will be converted to the **Open Category** and will be filled on **on merit during spot Admission.**

**PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO STUDENTS WHO ARE DOMICILE OF ASSAM. IF SEATS REMAINS VACANT: THOSE WILL BE FILLED BY APPLICANTS FROM OUTSIDE ASSAM BASED ON NTA-NCET SCORE.**

**7. RESTRICTIONS:**

- a) **For B.A.-B.Ed.:** All students must choose any one of the following subjects (**different from Core 1**) as Minor Course: **Assamese, Bengali, Bodo, Economics, Education, English, Geography, Hindi, History, Political Science, Sanskrit, Sociology.**
- b) **For B.Sc.-B.Ed.:** All students must choose any one of the following subjects (**different from Core 1**) as Minor Course: **Botany, Computer Science, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics and Zoology**


## 8. ADMISSION PROCESS:

The entire process of admission will be conducted online through the SAMARTH Portal (<https://assamadmitap.samarth.ac.in/index.php>). Candidates must register and submit their applications within the specified timeline as notified by the Director of Higher Education, Assam. Offline or manual applications will not be accepted under any circumstances. Selected candidates must produce their original documents for verification during the date of Admission as notified by Govt. of Assam.

9. **CURRICULUM:** The Curriculum and Programme structure as approved by Academic Council of Darrang College (Autonomous) will be strictly followed.

## FINAL NOTES

- a) Appearance of name in the merit list doesn't confirm admission.
- b) Admission shall remain provisional until all original documents have been verified by the college authorities.
- b) Any admission secured on the basis of false, inaccurate, or misleading information shall be cancelled immediately.
- c) The college reserves the right to amend, revise, or modify its admission policy in accordance with any guidelines, notifications, or directives issued by the Government of Assam or other competent regulatory authorities.
