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
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Name of the adopted village: Bahbari Deka Chuburi (Ward No.6)

Objectives: The College intends to adopt the village Bahbari Deka Chuburi, ward no. 6 to enhance the quality of life of the villagers in various aspects. The developmental activities are to be carried out with the help of local inhabitants/ local Panchayats/Govt. authorities and NGOs. Both faculties and students will be involved in the outreach programmes to be undertaken in the village. The college is committed to bring some qualitative changes in the village through this adoption with the help and co-operation of the local inhabitants.

Responsibility: All plan and programmes will be framed by IQAC and will be implemented through NSS, NCC, Youth Red Cross, Darrang College Students Union, Departmental Societies, Women Forum and other clubs and cells of the college.

Activities to be undertaken:

- 1. To conduct a socio-economic survey and geographical mapping of the village to have ideas about their socio-economic status and identify the areas to work on to improve the condition of life and fulfil some of their needs.
- 2. To create awareness among the villagers about the different developmental plans of state/ central government.
- 3. To develop the skills of the local unemployed youths for self-employment generation.
- 4. To make the village a clean and green village keeping in view the current need of making the environment eco-friendly with plantation of trees.
- 5. To educate the community about health and hygiene as well as reproductive health with the help of District Health Department.
- 6. To popularise science and scientific thinking among the young school students as well as villagers.
- 7. To conduct gender sensitization activities among the villagers and uplift the socioeconomic status of the community.
- 8. To work for women empowerment.
- 9. To create awareness about conservation and sustainable utilization of locally available plants and herbs and help them to make a data bank on the available resources.
- 10. To preserve and uphold the traditional beliefs/customs/culture and indigenous knowledge of the inhabitants.
- 11. To make the village an organic village.
- 12. To conduct training programmes about disaster management and preparedness.

Action Taken:

- 1. The Department of Education has surveyed the village and prepared a socio-economic profile of the village for plans to be implemented.
- 2. The Department of Geography has done a hazard mapping to identify the flood prone areas of the village.
- 3. An awareness meeting on 'Health and Hygiene' was held in the village on and sanitary pads, toothpaste, toothbrush and toilet soap were also distributed among the villagers.
- 4. Flood relief was given to the affected people in the village during the flood of 2022.





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
